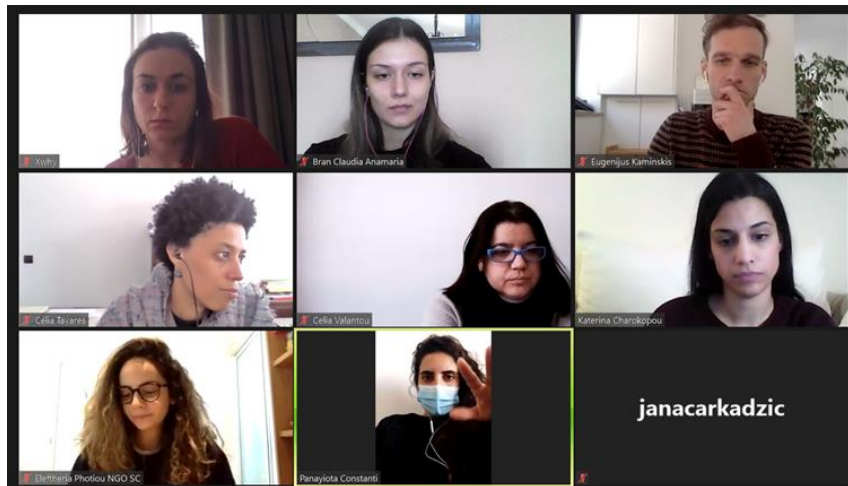

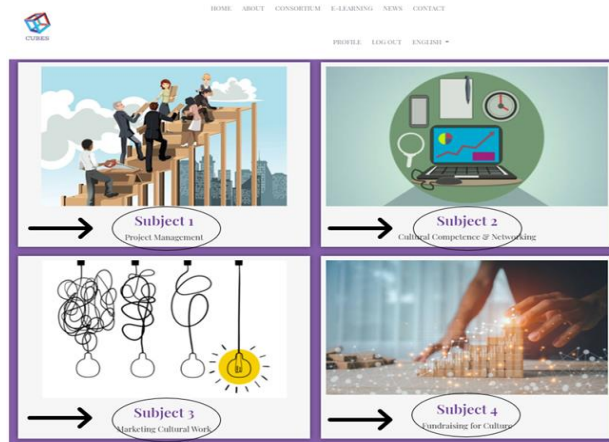

The last Intellectual Output coming, the **“Policy Paper” (IO5)** aspires to combine practice and theory, academic knowledge and policy drafting. More specifically, the “Policy Paper”:

- will include description of the evidence obtained, conclusions and guidelines for further research & renewal of existing practices,
- will promote relative policy recommendations and good practices for EU policymakers.

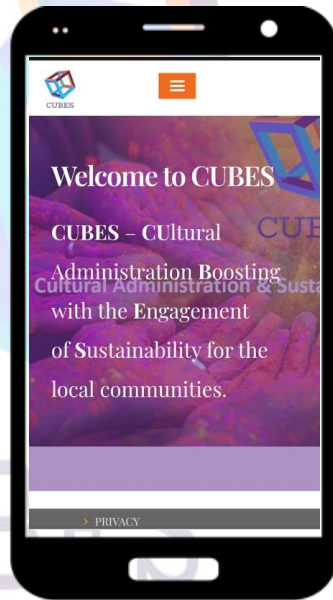
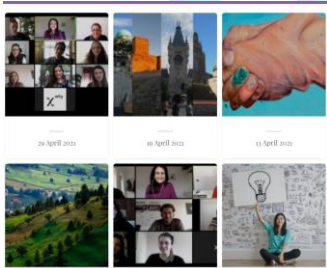
