DIVERSITe Project Concludes with Final Conference and Partners Meeting in Oberwart, Austria

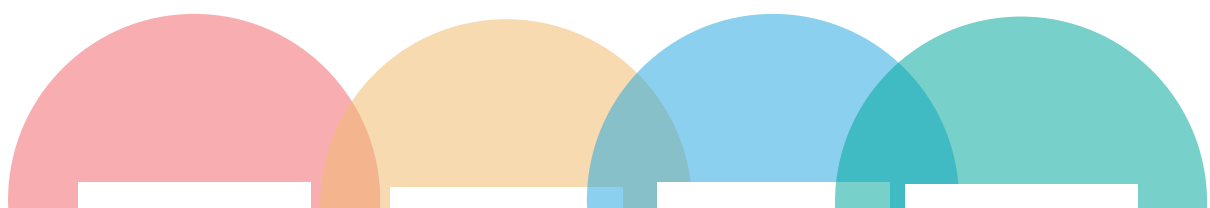

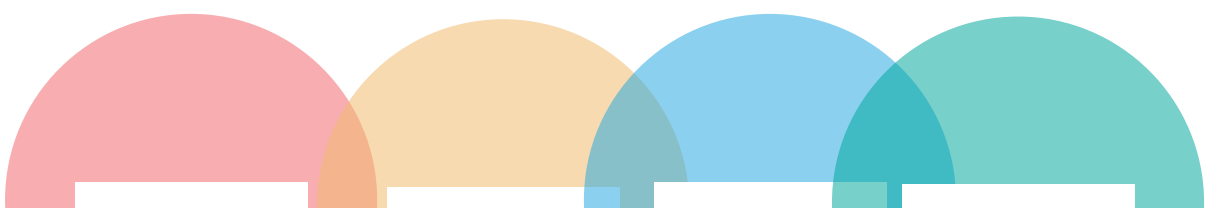
