Objectives of the Meeting

The partners met to lay the foundations of a transnational strategic partnership to make the Power Up Project a sustainable product. The issues discussed focused on project management, partners' roles and the intellectual outputs that aim at the integration of innovative methodologies and approaches to empower and enhance the competences of women with a migrant background for their self and professional development. The partners will work to enhance the key social, civic and entrepreneurial competences of migrant women to promote their social and financial independence and their participation in social and civic life. At the same time, the partnership will work to equip professionals and volunteers with practical knowledge and innovative techniques to deliver an empowerment and competency-based intervention

- ✓ **Training Curriculum** for an integral socio-labour intervention with young women, asylum seekers and refugees.
- ✓ **Open Educational Resource** for an integral socio-labor intervention with young women, asylum seekers and refugees.
