The RetroVET Project supports directly the European Green Deal as a new growth strategy and recognises the key role of vocational training for a successful transition to climate neutrality by 2050.

RetroVET aims to adapt vocational training to future labour market needs by supporting the development of innovative tools that will inspire VET centres to offer a balanced mix of vocational skills linked to existing and evolving occupations and working methods.



What is it for?

The Benchmarking Tool, as one of the project results, aims at helping teachers, trainers, practitioners, managers in VET institutions to identify how “green” their institution already is. By an easy to approach questionnaire related to specific “green areas”, which were identified as particularly important, like Accurate Accessible Information, Education and Training, Future Workforce, Human and Financial Resources, Policy and Governance, Professional Development, Promotion and Awareness and Sustainable Behaviour, the Benchmarking Tool supports reflecting on adopted green strategies, on the willingness to open up to new ones and on existing barriers to the implementation of new green strategies.

Which is the target group?

The target group are teachers, trainers, practitioners, managers in VET training institutions and other interested people in the VET field wanting to reflect on their own green approach.
