


Project SDG NAVIGATOR - Empowering changemakers towards sustainability

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The SDG NAVIGATOR project aims to empower individuals to drive sustainability by enhancing their entrepreneurial mindset and skills through innovative vocational education and training (VET). Key outcomes include a Sustainability Changemaker Competences Dictionary, a Sustainability NAVIGATOR Learning Path, and the SDG NAVIGATOR Hub and Toolbox. Targeting VET learners, providers, entrepreneurs, and other stakeholders, the project seeks to amplify individuals' impact on sustainability initiatives through personalized learning approaches and online resources.

The project SDG NAVIGATOR is a Erasmus+ KA2 CP VET financed project. The project duration is 24 months, from 31.12.2022 to 30.12.2024 and will be implemented by partners from Lithuania, Portugal, Spain, Greece, Slovenia and Austria.

The cornerstone achievements of the SDG NAVIGATOR project include the creation of the Sustainability Changemaker Competences Dictionary (SCCD), the Sustainability NAVIGATOR Learning Path (SNLP), and the SDG NAVIGATOR Hub and Toolbox. These resources are designed to foster an entrepreneurial mindset and enhance skills through innovative vocational education and training (VET), catering to diverse learners and amplifying their impact on sustainability initiatives.

Sustainability NAVIGATOR Learning Path (SNLP): SNLP offers individuals a comprehensive learning journey, comprising seven modules structured around sustainability-driven entrepreneurship stages. From preparation to outreach, each module is meticulously crafted to mobilize the competences outlined in the SCCD, guiding learners through the entrepreneurial process and empowering them to effect meaningful change.

SDG NAVIGATOR Digital Hub & Toolbox (SNDH): The online platform of SDG NAVIGATOR, SNDH, serves as a dynamic repository of learning resources and exploration paths on sustainability entrepreneurship. Integrating the SCCD and SNLP, SNDH facilitates personalized and action-oriented



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learning experiences, with interactive tools and thematic resources catering to educators, consultants, and individuals alike.

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SCCD defines the combination of knowledge, skills, and attitudes that could empower individuals to become true agents of change towards sustainability through their different life roles and choices eg: workers, citizens, consumers, etc. This latest addition to the SDG Navigator project is available in 6 different languages and includes key features concerning sustainability such as:

- **Comprehensive Competence Framework:** The SCCD outlines a holistic set of competences, encompassing knowledge, skills, and attitudes essential for driving sustainability initiatives.
- **Versatile Application:** Designed to empower individuals in diverse life roles and contexts, including as workers, citizens, consumers, activists, educators, and more.



The recent 3rd Transnational Partner Meeting, hosted in Nicosia (Cyprus) by CARDET on 30th and 31st January 2024, marked a significant milestone in the project's journey. Partners convened to discuss the finalization of Work Packages 2 and 3, including the completion of the Process Path and the Sustainability Changemakers Competences Dictionary (SCCD). Looking ahead, the 4th Transnational Partner Meeting, scheduled for May 2024, will transition to an online format, hosted by Meta4 Innovations, in lieu of an in-person gathering in Austria.
