What have we done so far?

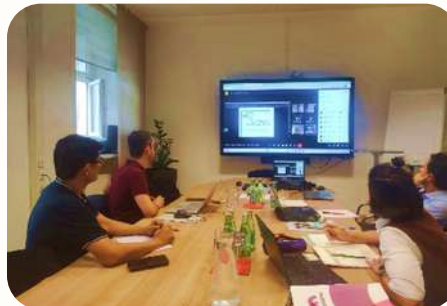
We are thrilled to announce a significant milestone achieved by the partners of the Secure Future Project – the completion of the European Framework on Cybersecurity Qualifications (Work Package 2) document. Our partners collaboratively conducted extensive desk research on cybersecurity policies, the landscape of cybersecurity in VET provision, and current qualifications across their respective countries. This document serves as a comprehensive map of essential competencies for VET teachers in IT, benefiting both institutions and SMEs seeking cybersecurity guidance.



We also successfully completed the third Work Package of the project, delivering the European Cybersecurity Training Curriculum. The curriculum defines clear learning outcomes, establishing the knowledge and skills learners are expected to acquire. It not only forms the basis for developing Training Content (WP 4) but also facilitates effective demonstration of cybersecurity achievements. The curriculum is a crucial tool for recognizing new skills, providing a structured framework for knowledge enhancement. Anticipating a positive impact, our partners will proceed to develop training content and an e-learning platform in the next project phase. All Project Results will be available in English, Turkish, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese, and German.



What are the next steps?



The Secure Future Training Content, intended to comprise 10 modules and a guide aiming to increase the utilization of project results in VET and SMEs training programs is scheduled for development in the coming months.
