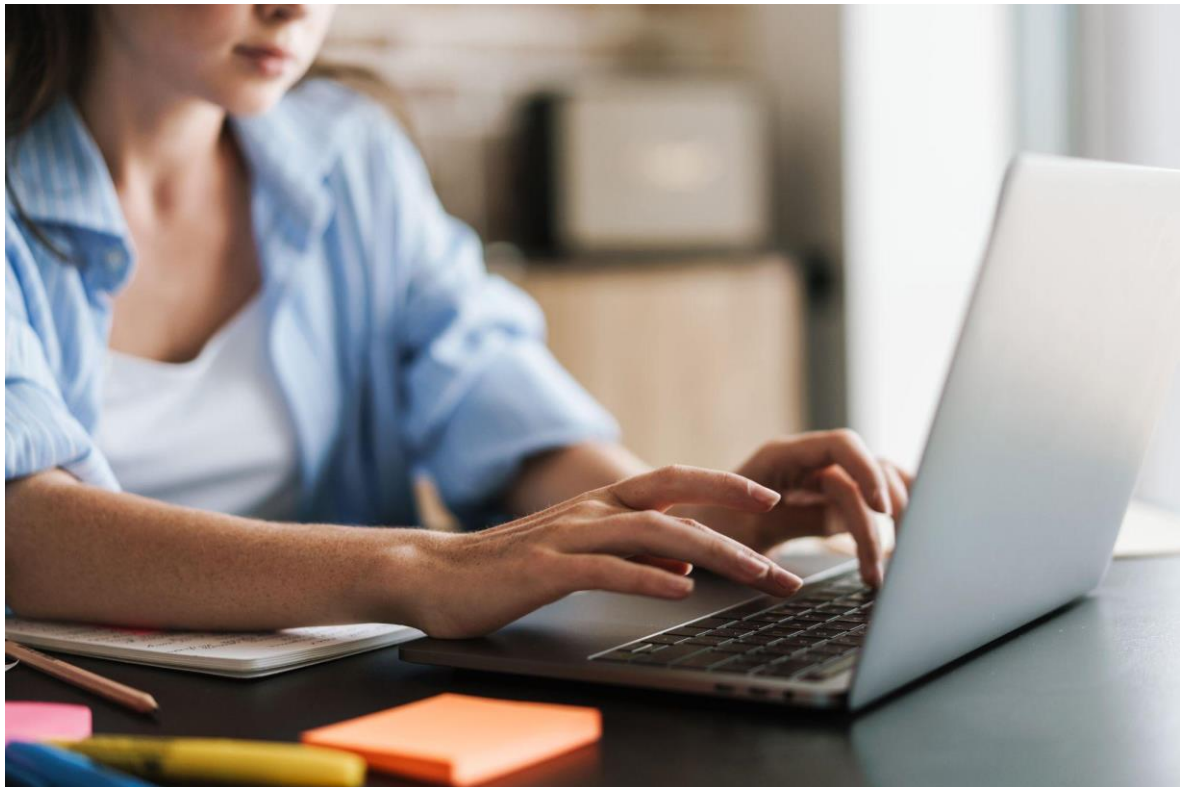

What is bEUjo+? An introduction

Education and training accessible and valuable for everyone – this is the mission of Erasmus+. The partners behind bEUjo+ deeply believe in it, as we have been engaged in many Erasmus+ projects over the years.

The project is implemented in cooperation by 6 partners coming from France, Portugal, Greece, Spain, and Germany:

- VHS Cham (Germany)

Inspired by the worldwide-known methodology of the **Bullet Journal**, the partnership will develop an **organizational tool for Erasmus+ project managers** in order to easily keep track of their projects. The tool will be available both in paper and digital form. This will be the first result bEUjo+.

The second Result will be a practical collection of documents and tools, called "**BOX+: coordinators' annex toolbox**". Its goal is to support newcomers in the Erasmus+ project in getting quickly familiar with the different dimensions of this business, especially regarding fundamental documents like contracts, timetables, proposals, and so forth.

Finally, the partners will develop a **Methodological Guide** to peer learning for training in Erasmus+ projects, also for newcomers in these kinds of activities. Trainers will be able to implement it in their own workplace so as to easily integrate the new workforce into the team.
