Overview of the activities of bEUjo+



What has bEUjo+ achieved so far?

The management of these Erasmus+ projects requires a great technical mastery of applications and documents, reflexes and organizational tools. The training of future/new coordinators and Erasmus+ project management teams usually takes place in the organizations that carry out these projects. The aim of bEUjo+ is to make Erasmus+ projects accessible to all entities.

For this purpose, bEUjo+ is developing an organizational **tool for Erasmus+ project managers** in order to easily keep track of their projects. This tool has been inspired by the worldwide-known methodology of the Bullet Journal.

The consortium is currently working on the creation of the second output, **BOX +: coordinator's "annex" toolbox**, a toolbox that will contain all relevant documents for the management of European projects. The objective is to understand how to use these documents and how to fill them in. It is a useful tool for all new project managers.

In parallel to the development of the **toolbox**, the consortium is working on the elaboration of the Methodological Guide to peer learning for training in Erasmus+ projects. The first step in the development of this guide is the compilation of **"best practices"**, a task on which the partners are currently working.

All these materials that are being developed will be available in "The bEUjo + web app", which is also being worked on for its implementation.

The consortium met last November in Piraeus (Greece) and the next face-to-face consortium meeting will be held on April 12th 2022 in Valladolid (Spain). The purpose of these meetings is to evaluate the work done and to set the next steps of the project. In addition to the face-to-face meetings, the consortium has held regular online meetings to monitor the day-to-day progress of the project.
